Risk Assessment

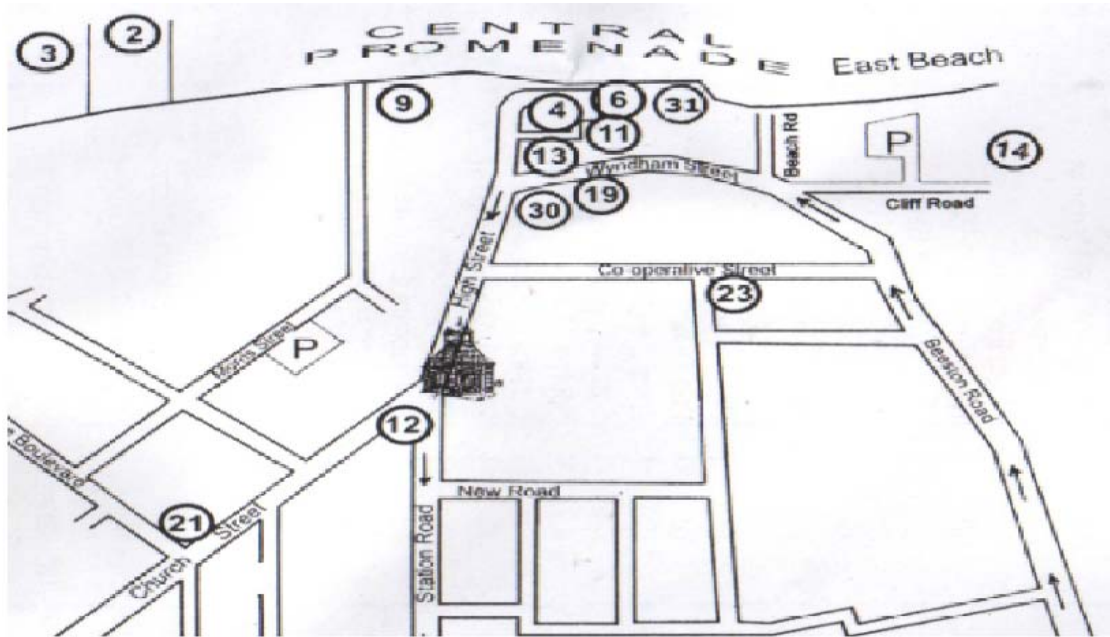
I certify that I have considered all risks in respect of the setting up, displaying and dismantling of the vehicle display and that I will abide by the following conditions to minimise risk:

- Filling or emptying of fuel tanks within the area is strictly prohibited at any time
- All vehicles should be positioned within the boundaries of the display so that any protrusions, doors, tail lifts, etc. do not infringe public access.
- Vehicles must be taxed and drivers be insured to drive vehicle.
- Applicants must ensure all drivers hold, and are not disqualified from holding, a licence to drive the class of vehicle being displayed.
- Road vehicles must be fully licensed and tested in accordance with the regulations for that type of vehicle not for road use.

- No exhibit may be left running unattended. All unattended vehicles must be securely braked and/or chocked and engines switched off.
- No vehicle may run on trade plates
- All vehicles are accepted into the show on condition that the authorities and the show organisers cannot be held responsible for exhibitors/ traders negligence involving damage or injury to vehicles or persons. Similar for loss or theft of vehicles, contents and equipment. Traders must ensure that they have public liability insurance cover.
- It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to ensure that all vehicles being driven have a minimum third party insurance cover. Roads traffic act rules apply on site.
- Vehicles entering and leaving are restricted to a maximum of walking speed of 3mph and no unauthorised movement of vehicles is permitted during Showtime until after 16.00. if you need to leave early it must be agreed with show marshals before moving who will then escort you out.
- No dangerous dogs allowed on site. Pets are the direct responsibility of their handlers and must be kept on a leash at all times, and any deposit to be cleared up.
- Whilst every effort is made to ensure a successful show the organisers accept nor responsibility for trading results for any reason eg weather, show attendances, stall position, competition etc and reserve the right to close down the show at any time should circumstances beyond our control necessitate such actions.

Conditions of entry

- Vehicles must arrive between 10.00 and 16.00 on Sunday the 8th of august and must remain on site and on display for the entire show. Vehicles may depart on Sunday the 8th of august after 16.00 hours.
- Exhibitors must pay full regard to marshals' instructions and conduct themselves in a manner that will not inconvenience or endanger other persons, exhibits at any time
- Applicants wishing to display a military vehicle with any form of weapon must include a copy of the deactivation certificate with this application form for consideration of approval.
- Late entrees after 11 o'clock may be admitted on the day subject to space limitations



Roads closed for the classic car show will be station road, down to the clock tower, the main high street, Wyndham Street, Gun Street and the chequers car park on the sea front.
